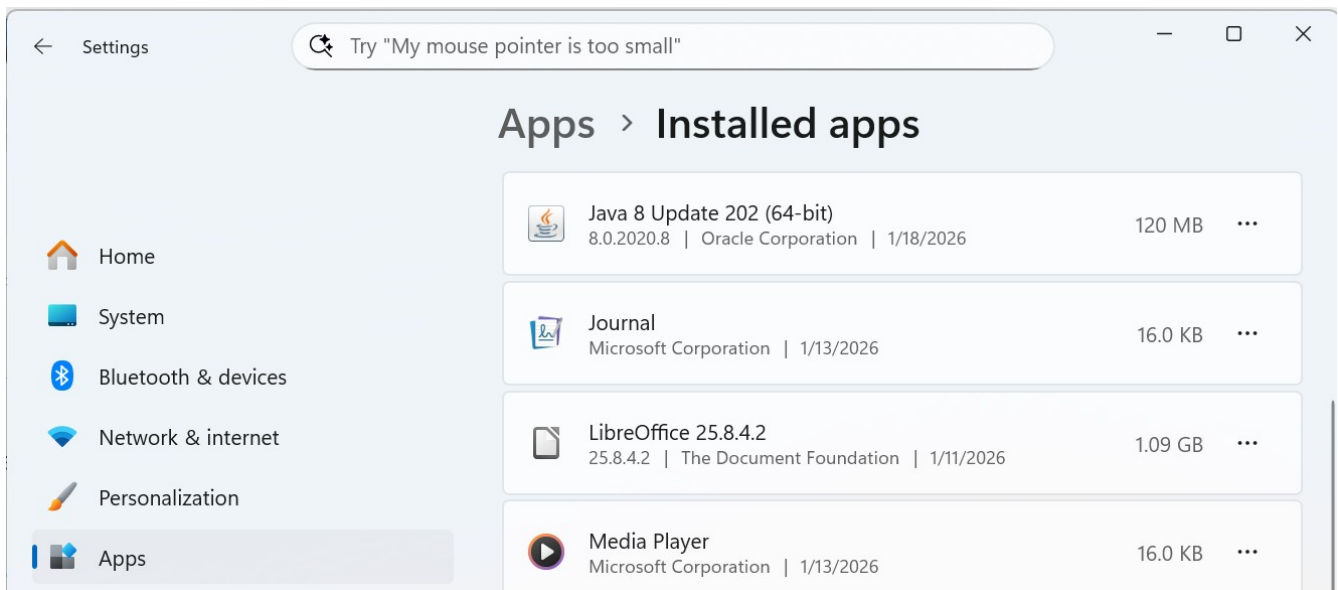


# How to replace Oracle Java Web Start

For improved security older versions of Java being used to access iconcontrol should be updated to Open Web Start.

## Uninstall Java

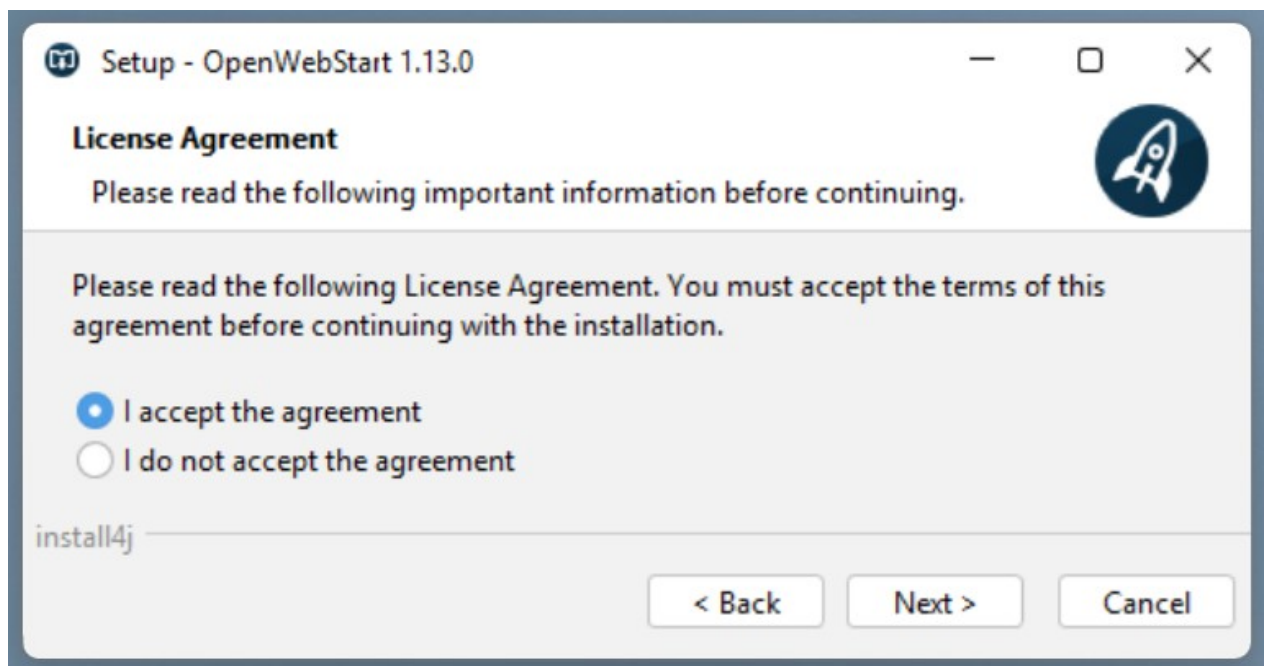
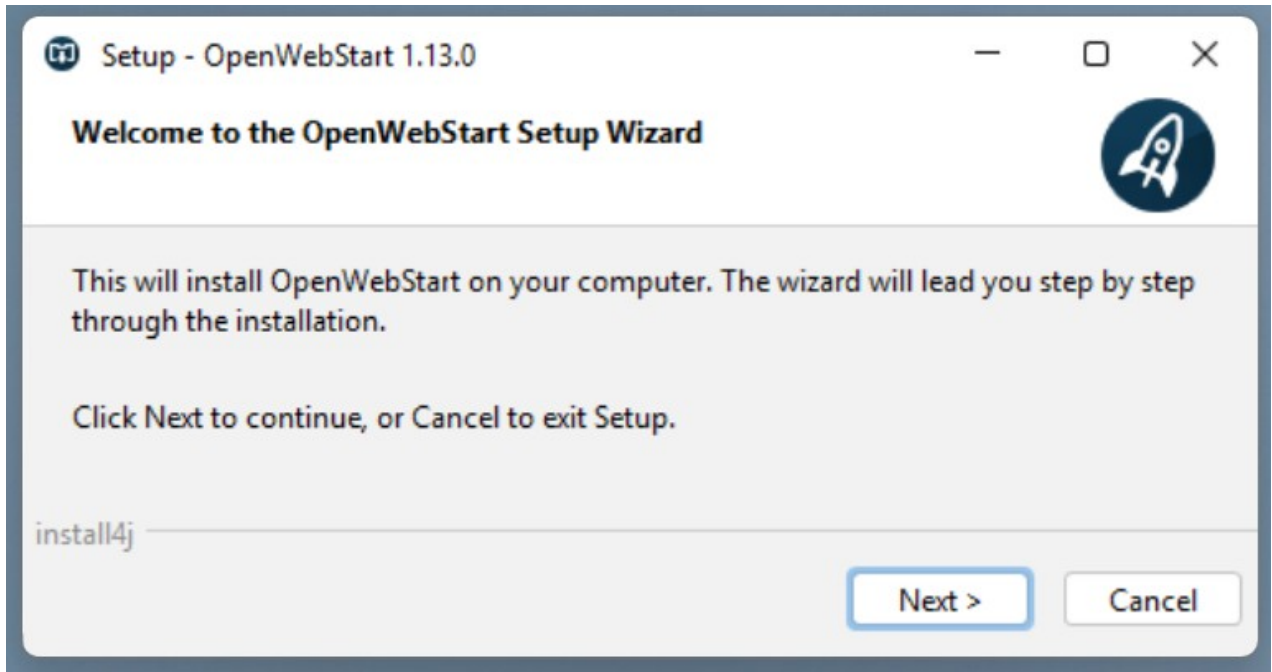
1. **Open Settings:** Click the **Start** button (Windows icon) and select **Settings** (the gear icon).
2. **Go to Apps:** Click **Apps**, then **Installed apps** (Windows 11) or **Apps & features** (Windows 10).
3. **Uninstall:** Find the Java app, click the **three dots (...)** (Win 11) or the app itself (Win 10), and select **Uninstall**. Follow the on-screen prompts.



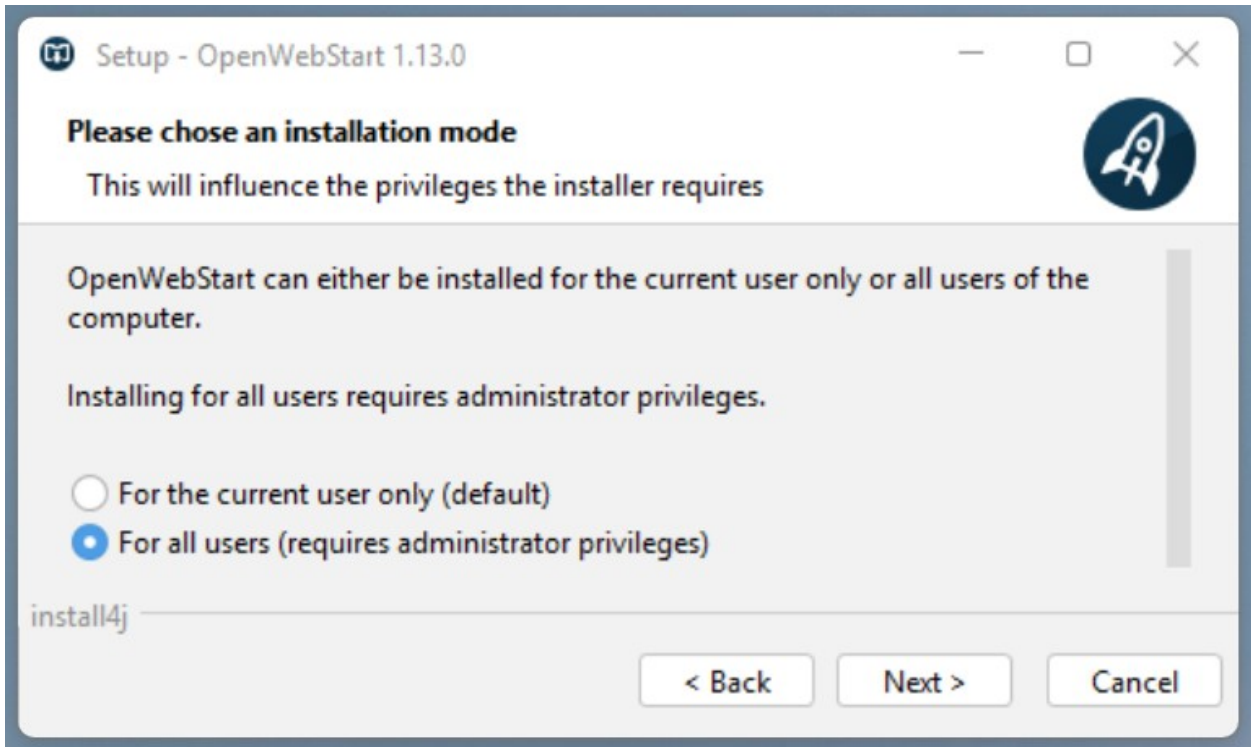
## Install Open Web Start

**Download the Installer:** Visit the official [OpenWebStart Download page](#) and select the Windows x64 (64-bit) installer.

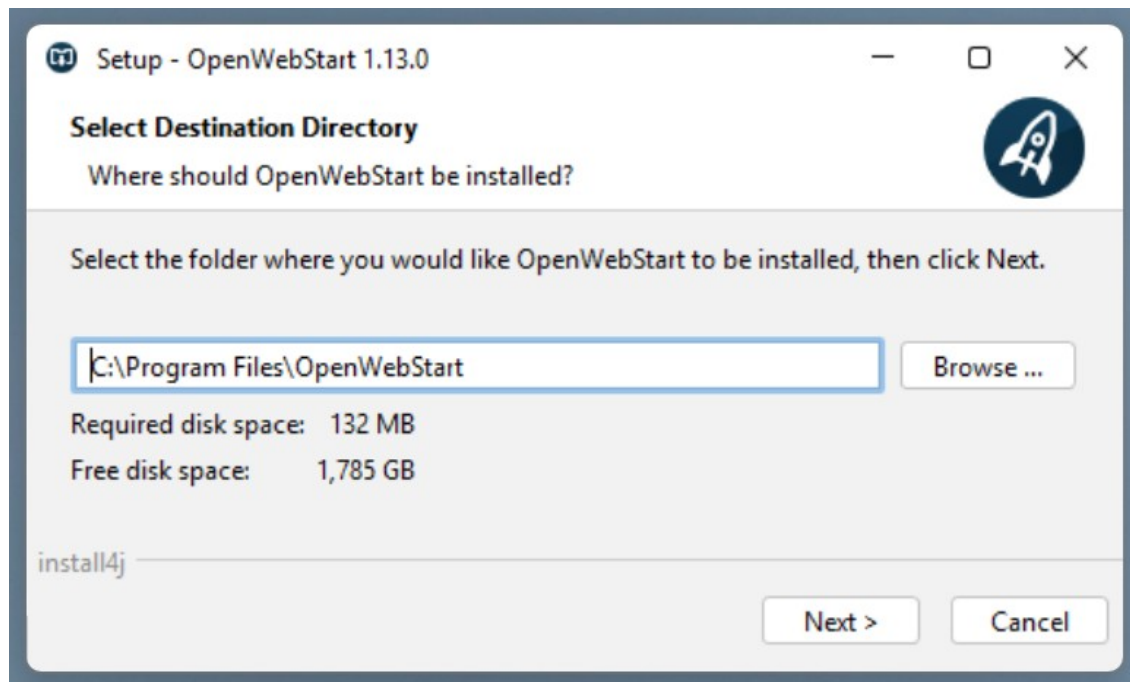
**1.Run the Executable:** Locate the downloaded `.exe` file and double-click to launch the setup wizard.



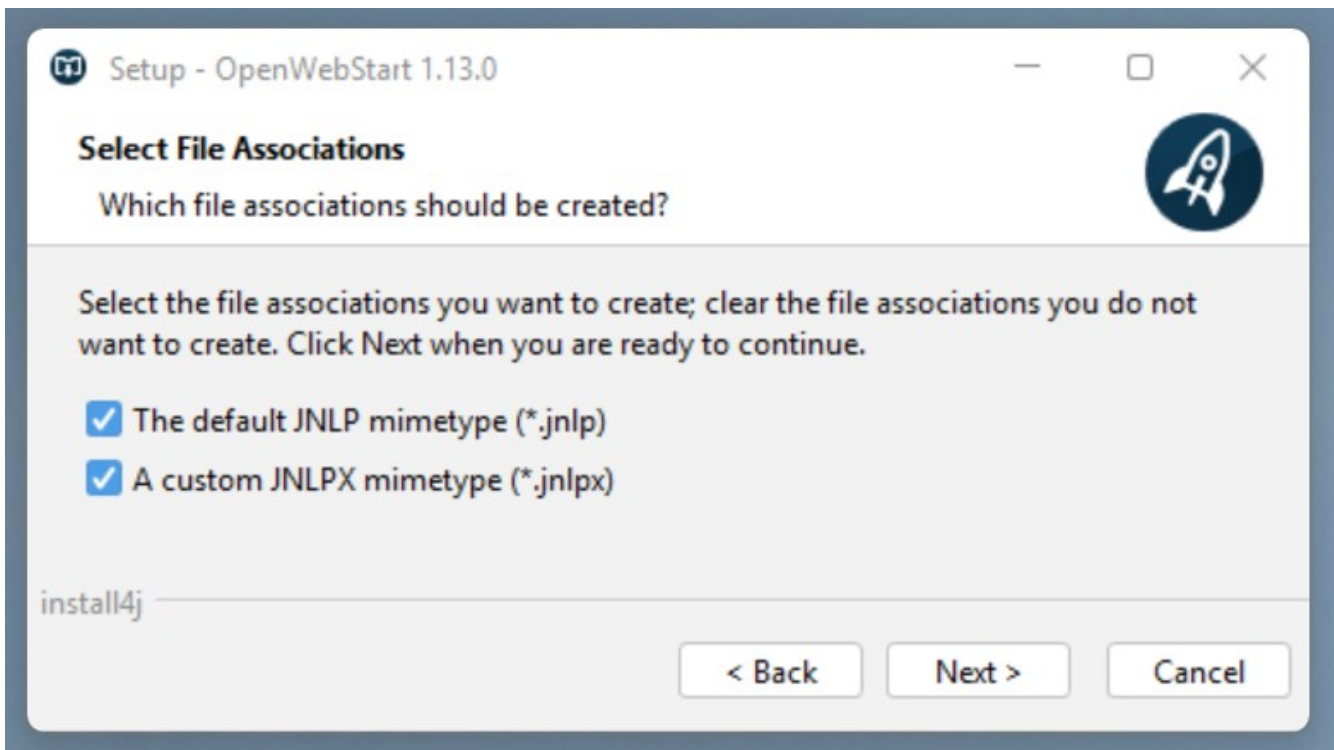
2. **Permissions:** If prompted, select **For all users** (requires administrator privileges) to ensure proper file associations across the system.



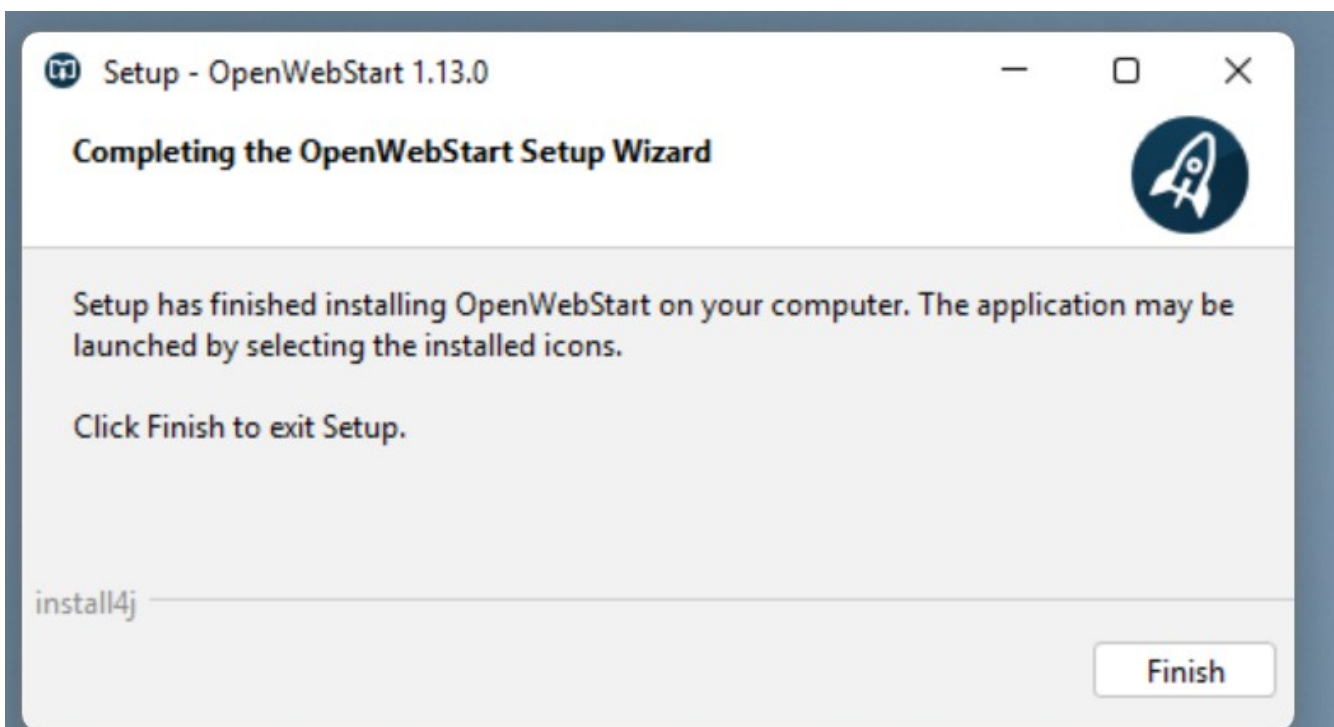
3. **Accept Defaults:** Follow the on-screen prompts, accept the license agreement, and use the default installation directory (typically C:\Program Files\OpenWebStart).



**4. File Association:** Ensure the checkbox to **associate .JNLP and .JNLFX suffixes** is checked during installation. This allows you to launch Java apps simply by double-clicking their JNLP files.



**5. Finish:** Click **Finish** to complete the process.

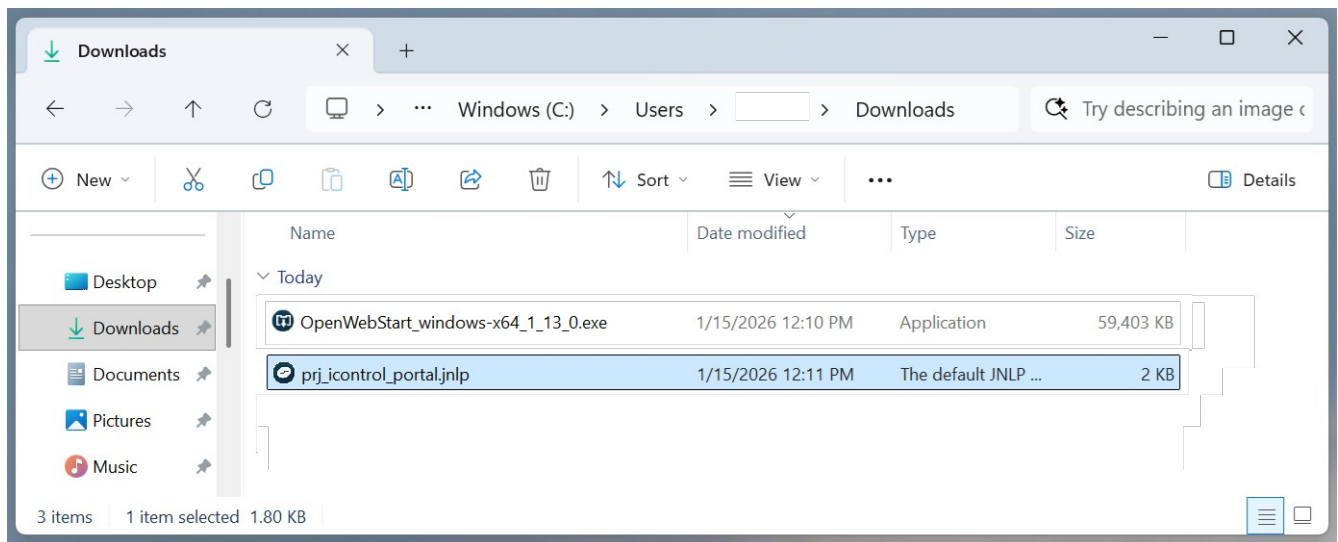


6. **Download the iconcontrol JNLP file:** Go to <https://www.iconcontrolsolutions.com/>

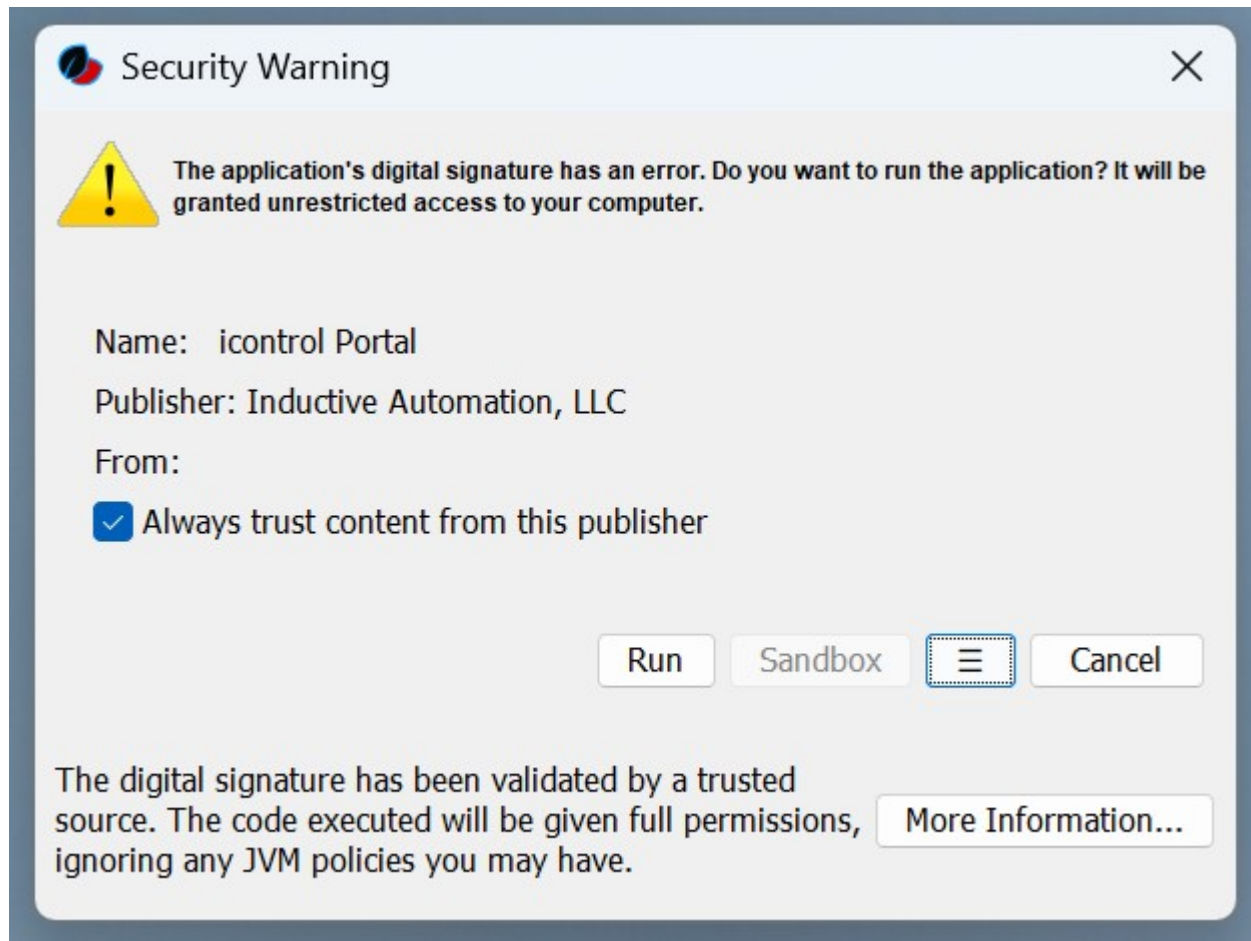

8. **Trust the content and Run:** Click on Always trust content from this publisher. Click on Run
